<p>This is a painting about pandemic lockdowns. In 2020 my family had planned to take our first overseas holiday. This was thwarted by the pandemic, which devastated many parts of the world. Travel — indeed free movement for many people — was limited to a designated radius around one's house. Those lucky enough to have a pet dog had an excuse to take walks outside; one of the few ways that people could ward off torpor and depression during lockdowns. "Travel", in such circumstances, became more of an imaginary pursuit. Just as ancient astronomers once looked at the night sky and saw the constellation Argo Navis, the Argo Ship, sailing away to Colchis in search of a Golden Fleece, I would look up at the sky breaking through the tree canopy and see a winding river. In this way, the familiar dog-walking route through my local park became a pathway to the world beyond. It allowed me to imagine a day when we'll be able to travel again, and see the world beyond our own neighbourhood.</p>
