# TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The artist must be a **resident** of South Australia at 1st Jan 2023
- 2. Maximum of three entries per artist
- 3. Your artwork must be:
- An original work, created and owned by the submitting artist;
- Works to be completed after January 2022;
- In oil, acrylic, watercolour, pastel, mixed media, drawing, original print, photography; textile, digital or sculpture;
- Completely dry, suitably presented (eg. sides of a stretched canvas painted or clean white) and ready to hang with 'D' rings or display in a condition which is safe to handle.
- The non-refundable entry fee For 2D works: up to 70cm wide: \$15 (members) \$20 (non-members)

Up to 100cm wide: \$20 (members) \$25 (non-members); Up to 150cm wide: \$30 (members) \$35 (non-members). Maximum width = 150cm;

- The non-refundable entry fee for 3D entries: \$20 (members), \$25 (non-members), max weight 20kgs.
- 4. The judges and organisers reserve the right to declare **ineligible** any work that does not conform to their interpretation of the terms and conditions of entry.
- 5. All art works **must be for sale**. 30% commission to RSASA will apply to all sales.
- 6. The judges have **absolute discretion** in selecting the Finalists, the winner, and all other prize recipients. The judges' decision will be final and not subject to discussion or appeal. No correspondence will be entered in to.

- 12. Entry fee is payable by cash; cheque; money order; credit card (details on entry form) **OR** direct deposit, cheque/money order payable to Royal South Australian Society of Arts. Direct deposit to **BSB 015-010 Account 6058-61014**.
- 13. **Digital images** (**preferred**) must be: jpg format; of a resolution of **no less than 300dpi**; less than 3000x3000 pixels per image; file size not to exceed five (5) megabytes per image.

**File naming protocol** – artist's **first** name, **family** name, **title** of work, **h** x w (in cm for 2D), h x w x d (in cm for 3D work), **medium**, **price**.

**JUDGING.** To ensure an exhibition with a high standard of work judging will happen in **two stages by a panel of three judges**. The judges reserve the right to reject work if the conditions outlined in this form are not met.

Judges select finalists via .jpg images and choose prize winners by viewing the actual work hanging on the RSASA gallery wall.

INSURANCE. Artists are advised to insure their works against loss or damage for the 2023 RSASA Abstract Prize competition during the periods of traveling, handling, judging, exhibition, and storage. All

reasonable care is taken with all entries, but the Royal South
Australian Society of Arts takes no responsibility whatsoever for
loss or damage however caused to any works submitted.

**DELIVERY OF WORK** Finalists can deliver work to the RSASA Gallery, The Institute (1st Floor), corner North Tce & Kintore Ave Adelaide SA 5000 on: Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June or Tuesday 20<sup>th t</sup> June 2023, between 10.30am and 3pm.

**Label on work**: attach label to rear left-hand-side of each work AND include name of the artist, title of work, size (h x w cm) medium and price. **Labels and consignment forms on the RSASA web site**.
