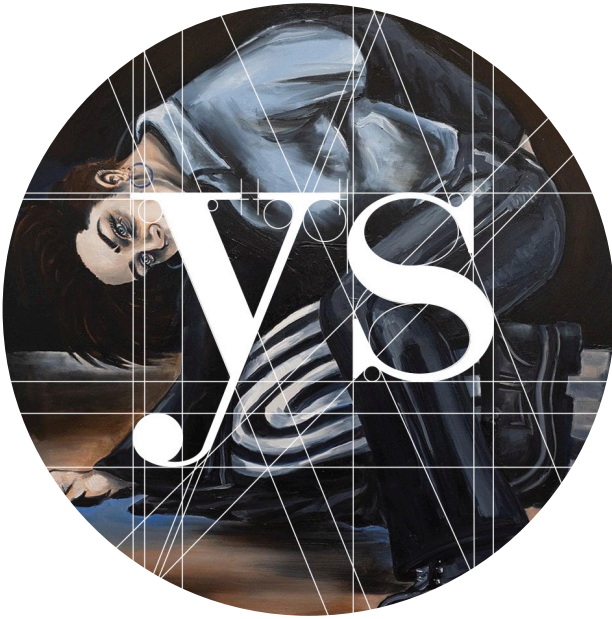


YOUTHSCAPE 2024

Works of art should be original work of the artist and not copied. Due to limited space not all entries may be exhibited.

Age stated as of 31st May 2024

1. Entry form & Conditions of Entry: Complete entry form and number the box of how many categories you intend to exhibit.

Each artist can enter a maximum of two artworks per category.

Awards of artistic relevance will be given, the decision of the judges will be final.

2. Conditions: Entry forms be received either by post, email or to RSASA Gallery.

Works of art should be original work of the artist and not copied and have been completed within the last two years.

Due to limited space it may be that not all works are displayed, but the aim is to hang all works at the discretion of organisers.

3. How to enter: Complete entry form, which can be located on www.rsasarts.com.au or at the Royal SA Society of Arts Gallery and returned to the gallery either via post at PO Box 177 Rundle Mall, Adelaide

5000, or email to rsasarts@bigpond.net.au or drop in to the RSASA Gallery, Level 1, Institute Bldg., Cnr North Tce & Kintore Ave, Adelaide 5000.

4. Hanging requirements: Artists are allowed up to two artworks in each category, no larger than 1m x 1.5m.

Works must be of gallery standard ie. ready for hanging, mounted or framed, with "D" rings as required.

5. Size of artwork:

2D artworks max size - 1m x 1.5m,
3D artworks max size - 1m x 2m floor, max weight 20kg, max size 600 x 600mm for plinth.

6. Delivery of artwork/s: Tuesday 28 May 2024 between 10.30 - 4.30pm or by arrangement with RSASA (rsasarts@bigpond.net.au).

Upon delivery of artwork/s, a consignment form requiring name, titles of works, prices, and comments about artwork will be provided, but will also be emailed to artists prior to delivery.

If you have images of your artwork/s jpeg images can be emailed to rsasarts@bigpond.net.au giving name, medium & size, which may be used for publicity purposes and to be used in the catalogue.

7. Insurance: The RSASA will endeavour to undertake careful handling of artworks whilst in the RSASA Gallery, but artworks are exhibited at the risk of the artist. The RSASA take no responsibility whatsoever for any loss or damage caused to any works exhibited.

8. Sale of artwork: Artworks can be for sale, a 30% commission applied by RSASA. Works for sale should be priced accordingly or marked Not for Sale.

Payment of sales will be made within one month of the completion of the exhibition, to the youth artist by the RSASA. Bank details will be required for any payments.

9. Collection of Artwork/s: Tuesday 25th June from RSASA Gallery between 10.30 - 4.30pm or by prior arrangement.

10. Copyright: Copyright of the work remains the property of the artist and such right shall not be sold, licensed, or otherwise dealt with by the RSASA without written permission from the artist. RSASA reserves the right to use images of the artwork for advertising, gallery website and social media.

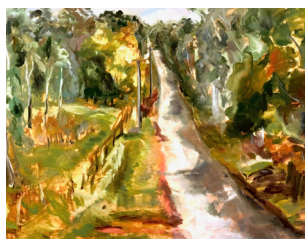
